



## Announcement of Faculty of Humanities, Chiang Mai University

### Subject: English Standardized Test Score Equivalence for Exemption from Fundamental English Courses

CMU Students who meet the required English standardized test score results will be eligible for exemption from the specified Fundamental English courses and will be evaluated according to Item 16.4 (2) of Chiang Mai University Regulations on Undergraduate Study 2553 and 2561 B.E. (2010 and 2018). The Faculty of Humanities, Chiang Mai University, hereby announces the equivalent scores for the exemption from the specified Fundamental English courses as follows:

1. This announcement becomes effective from the first semester of Academic Year 2023 onwards.
2. Announcement of Faculty of Humanities, Chiang Mai University on English Standardized Test Score Equivalence for Exemption from Fundamental English Courses dated on 20th June 2565 B.E. (2022) is now superseded.
