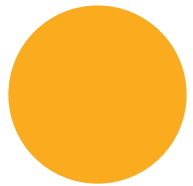

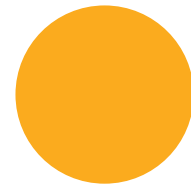
- Cultural adjustment

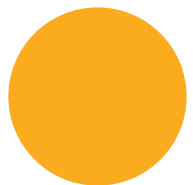
We offer workshops to help you integrate all these new skills



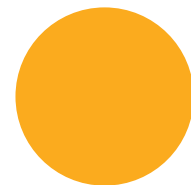
