

### ACCOMMODATION INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SHARED HOUSE



All EPOK students stay at **\*the International Student Shared House** on campus. Students share a unit with one Japanese student and two other international students. Every unit is single sex, has a common room with kitchen facilities, a bathroom, a toilet, and four private rooms. Not only is it within ten minutes walking distance from Tsushima Campus, it also offers a great opportunity to experience customs and cultures of both Japan and other parts of the world.

**\*The dormitory where students stay may change depending on the period of their acceptance and students cannot choose which dormitory they will stay at.**  
**\*The monthly rent and utility fee vary by dormitory.**
