

Information on the New Student Residence and Accommodation Arrangements for Spring 2027 Exchange Students

Seikei University is scheduled to open a new student residence, International College MICHl, in September 2027.

As the residence will open after the start of the Spring 2027 exchange period, students staying for a full academic year will initially live in existing university accommodation and will be required to move to International College MICHl once it opens.

Residence Fee

Monthly Fee: JPY 120,000

The monthly fee includes:

- Room charge
- Management fee
- Breakfast and dinner on weekdays during the academic term
- Utilities (electricity, gas and water)
- Internet access
- Bed linen

Please note:

No deposit is required.

Cleaning fees are included.

The fee is non-refundable.

Meals are not provided on weekends or during long vacation periods.

Payment Method

Payment can be made by bank transfer or at a convenience store.

Please note that a lump-sum payment may be required. Further details regarding payment will be provided at a later date.

Accommodation Arrangements**For Students Staying for One Academic Year****March 2027 – August 2027**

Students will stay in either:

- Dormy Inokashira-Koen, or
- Seikei International House

From September 2027

Students will be required to move to International College MICHI.

As a result:

- Students will need to change accommodation during their exchange period.
- The residence fee for International College MICHI will apply after the move.
- The relocation will be arranged and carried out by Seikei University.

Important:

Please note that students staying for one academic year will be required to relocate during their exchange period, and the accommodation fee will change accordingly once they move to International College MICHI.

Students who choose not to stay in university accommodation and instead arrange their own housing will be responsible for all associated costs.

For Students Staying for One Semester**March 2027 – Early August 2027**

Students will stay in either:

- Dormy Inokashira-Koen, or
- Seikei International House

No move to International College MICHI will be required.
